Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

The Catholic Church has a rich history in the United States. Today, we continue to build the Church by the witness of our lives as baptized Catholics.

Soon you will be asked by your parish to participate in the Annual Collection for the **Black and Indian Missions**. Your contributions support missionaries here in the United States who are evangelizing in the Black and Indigenous Catholic communities. Your monetary sacrifices assist in continuing the mission of Jesus Christ in many ways, including mission schools, religious education programs, ministry training and the purchase of catechetical materials and bibles. Money from this collection is returned to our diocese to help with our ministry on the five Native American reservations of western South Dakota.
