

As we begin the Lenten Season, we begin our "walk" through the Mass by examining From Father the way that we prepare for Mass. We pre-Christensen pare for almost everything in life. We pre-

pare for meals, for celebrations or parties, for work, for presentations, for vacation, for school, for sports, for plays, etc. Preparation is an essential aspect of life. Without preparation everything would be chaos and confusion. Therefore, preparation for Mass is an essential aspect of our Sunday worship. Several ways that people prepare for Sunday Mass: reading the Sunday Scripture Readings throughout the week; discussing the readings with family or friends; reviewing the homily from the previous week; spending time in daily prayer; turning off the radio on the way to Mass; praying the Rosary on the way to church; thinking of an intention to offer during Mass; arriving at church early to spend sometime in quiet prayer before Mass; making a visit to the Blessed Sacrament during the week; offering prayers and lighting a votive candle; making a good Sacramental Confession prior to Mass; leaving early and arriving early for Mass. If we are not well prepared for Mass, then we may feel disconnected from Mass, disconnected from the Church, and even disconnected from God. Preparation for Mass is essential to celebrating well and entering into this great mystery of our faith. Praise be Jesus Christ! Now and forever!
